# **Ethical Leadership in Business** (MGMT 3940)

Management & Leadership Major Course

Ethical leadership entails the signaling of moral emotions and prosocial behaviors toward pertinent stakeholders. This requires an understanding of the individual and organizational factors that impact ethical choice and decision- making. Students will learn how to identify the various factors leading to unethical behavior and how leaders and organizations mitigate these risks to achieve ethical conduct.

- Ethical Leaders Standout Interview (Interview a local Tennessee business leader who exemplifies ethical leadership using Jones College's ethical decision-making criteria. In Spring, the class selects the recipient of the Jill Austin Ethical Leadership Award).
